


## TAP EXTENSION HOSE KIT

 $\overline{RT 100} = \overline{RED}$   $\overline{RT 200} = \overline{BLUE}$   $\overline{RT 300} = \overline{GREEN}$ 

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Remove the tap from your GoatThroat Pump by carefully unscrewing the four screws which secure the tap to the Pump body. Ensure that the screws are not damaged and are suitable for re-use. Remove the "O" ring (marked A) and check for damage. If damaged, replace.
- 2. Fit the "O" ring to the Pump end of the extension hose assembly and gently attach to the Pump body using the 4 screws removed from the tap. Ensure the "O" ring has been fitted correctly (if not your pump may leak). DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN SCREWS.



## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Pressurize your container
- 2. Release liquid by pressing handle on remote tap
- 3. To empty unused fluids back into container:
  - a. release pressure in container
  - b. hold accessory and hose extension higher than pump
  - c. open tap on accessory
  - d. let fluid drain completely into original container

## **CAUTIONS AND WARNINGS**

- 1. Please read GoatThroat Instruction Manual completely before use.
- 2. Use pump only with approved liquids as specified in GoatThroat Liquids and Chemicals Compatibility Guide. Use of a GoatThroat pump with any non-approved substances may damage the pump and could cause risk of personal injury resulting from exposure to potentially hazardous substances.
- 3. Exercise caution when mixing liquids, especially hazardous chemicals. During pressure release, high concentrations of potentially hazardous vapors may be released.
- 4. Always wear appropriate protective equipment when working with potentially hazardous substances.
- 5. The tubing is PVC. Ensure that PVC is rated for use with your fluid.
- 6. Use of the pump with any non-approved fluids will void the warranty.
