



## QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE SELLING GOATTHROAT PUMP

- If fluid not on list, get name of fluid, manufacturer, and a telephone number and send to/call us.
- If we cannot determine compatibility, we will send the customer a test kit to determine compatibility. The cost is \$10.

Size of container \_\_\_\_\_ Steel or Plastic \_\_\_\_\_ Is the container a pail with a soft top or a drum type configuration?

Describe the opening \_\_\_\_\_

- Size of opening \_\_\_\_\_ (for standard pump, must be between 1 3/4 " and 2 3/4 " and have a vertical dimension of at least 1/2 - 3/4 " or a custom adapter may be necessary.)
- Does it have a 2" fine internal thread (NPT) or a 2.5" coarse thread (buttruss) in the bung hole?
- If an internal buttruss thread, the customer must purchase a buttruss adapter or the pump won't work.
- If the customer has a 2" NPT opening, we will recommend that you recommend a standoff kit. See if he wants the 12" standoff. Ask what size his receiving container is.
- If a Rieke pour spout, recommend the appropriate adapter.

Does the customer wish a remote tap with his pump? This allows point of use delivery of the fluid

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Does the customer want a shop air adapter? \_\_\_\_\_

Is the fluid viscous or oily? \_\_\_\_\_ If yes, recommend a single tube.
